Senlanne, Altus 2023 Vin de France

Full bottle 1,144 g. Grenache Blanc with some Clairette grown at 250 m on limestone scree near Balaruc in the Hérault region of Languedoc. Hand-picked, spontaneous fermentation, minimal intervention, unfined, unfiltered. Total added sulphites 18 mg/l. 1,052 bottles made.

The scent of linden blossom on the nose, with that little bready bee-pollen aroma that Grenache Blanc so often throws. Delicately floral, delicate fruit and yet the energy in this wine is like a whipcrack of electricity. Bergamot and hops, and an appetising sour bite to it, not unlike a lambic beer. Into the edgy spectrum but controlled. (TC)
