Senlanne, Arsis 2023 Vin de France

Full bottle 1,295 g. 100% Grenache Noir. Biodynamic viticulture, spontaneous fermentation. Nicolas Senlanne believes in as little intervention as possible. He works without pumps, pressing is manual in a ratchet press. Tiny production – this is bottle 147 of 972.

Floral, pure and stunningly pellucid. The tannins are long and plentiful but very fine and finely spiced. They seem to hold and carry the fruit like a sailing ship carries its sails. The fruit is filled with sweetness but it's not 'sweet'. Wild strawberries, pencil, tobacco and anise. Diaphanous. Thrilling wine. (TC)
